INSTITUTE SCHOLARSHIPS

To promote Meritorious Students Institute provides following scholarships to the students seeking admission for the Session 2016-17.

- Counselling Scholarship:** Each student admitted through UPSEE 2016 counselling shall be given an annual scholarship of 10% of the Government Sanctioned Fee of the Institute (i.e. Rs. 91,200). This scholarship is not available to directly admitted students of the Institute. **(Total Rs. 9,120×4 = 36,480/-).**
- For Girls Special scholarship “**बेटियों को पढ़ाओ काबिल बनाओ**” of **Rs. 10000/-** per year in all courses **(Rs. 10,000×4 = 40,000/-).**

Merit Scholarship “Each admitted student of the Institute in 2016 shall be eligible for the following amounts of scholarship based in the percentage of marks obtained in PCM in Class XII Board examinations or on the basis of SEE 2016 rank obtained in the entrance exam conducted by AKTU”.

- Students having **PCM 95% and above** in 12th or **SEE Rank-2016 from 1 to 5,000** will get a scholarship of **Rs. 80,000/-** per year **(Rs. 80,000 × 4 = 3,20,000/-).**
- Students having **PCM 90% to below 95%** in 12th or **SEE Rank-2016 from 5,001 to 10,000** will get a scholarship of **Rs. 50,000/-** per year **(Rs. 50,000 × 4 = 2,00,000/-).**
- Students having **PCM 85% to below 90%** in 12th or **SEE Rank-2016 from 10,001 to 20,000** will get a scholarship of **Rs. 30,000/-** per year **(Rs. 30,000 × 4 = 1,20,000/-).**
- Students having **PCM 80% to below 85%** in 12th or **SEE Rank-2016 from 20,001 to 30,000** will get a scholarship of **Rs. 20,000/-** per year **(Rs. 20,000 × 4 = 80,000/-).**
- Students having **PCM 75% to below 80%** in 12th or **SEE Rank-2016 from 30,001 to 40,000** will get a scholarship of **Rs. 15,000/-** per year **(Rs. 15,000 × 4 = 60,000/-).**
- Students having **PCM 70% to below 75%** in 12th or **SEE Rank-2016 from 40,001 to 50,000** will get a scholarship of **Rs. 10,000/-** per year **(Rs. 10,000 × 4 = 40,000/-).**

Note: Students have to maintain minimum 70% marks in each year of their respective courses

Note1: Only one scholarship among Counselling, Girl Student or Merit Scholarship may be availed by any student in any one year. Higher amount of Scholarship will be given to the students.

Note2: Students admitted against Tuition Fee Waiver (TFW) scheme are not eligible for the above stated scholarships.
