

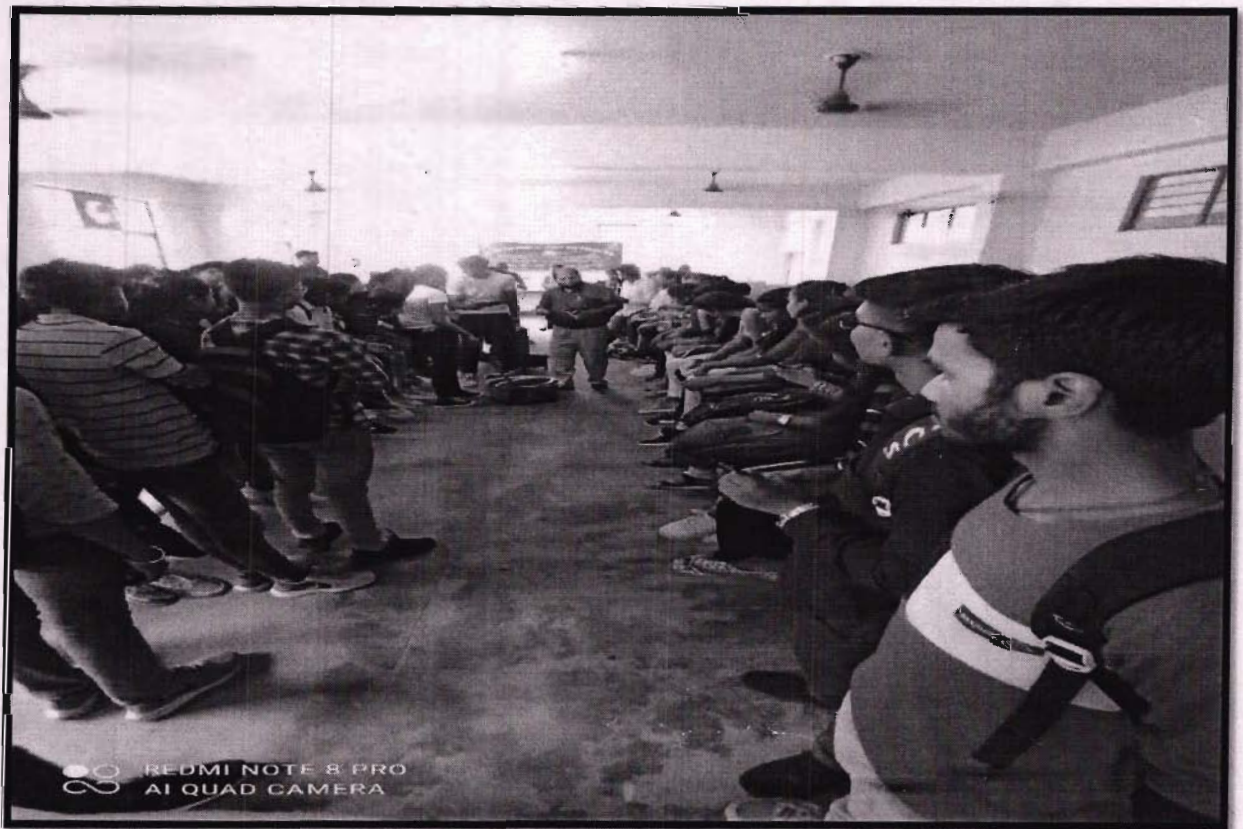
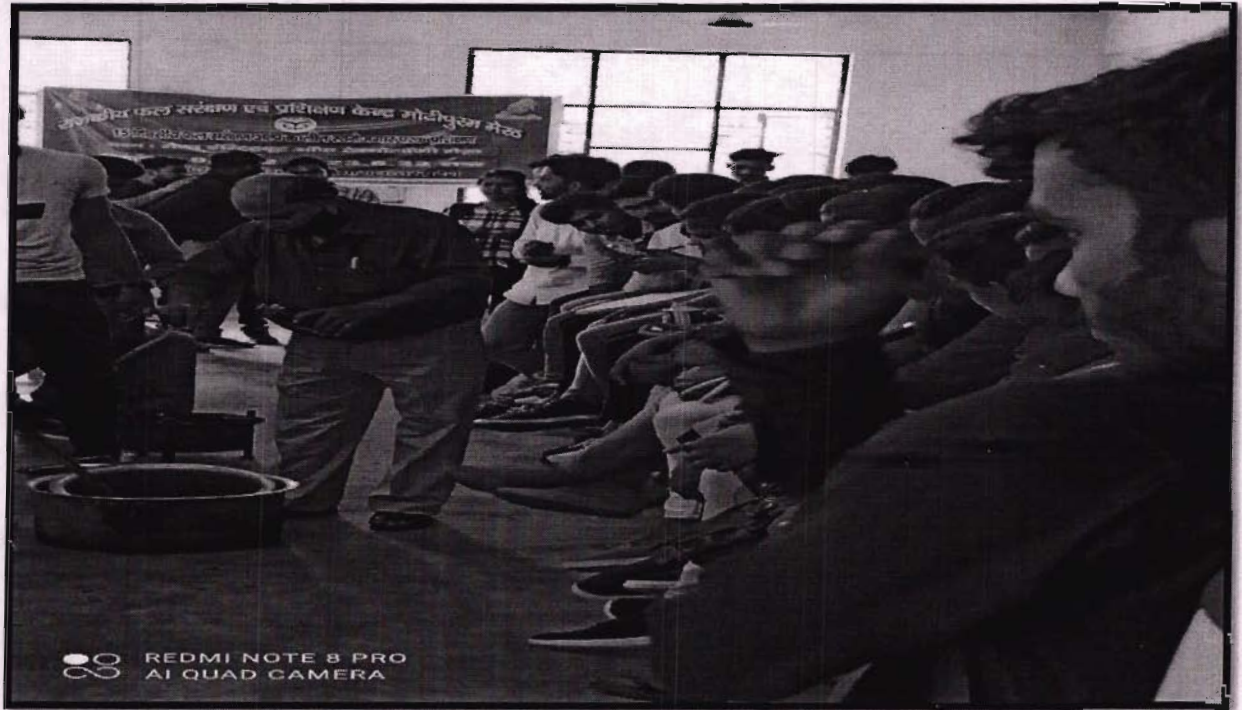
Workshop/Training:

Training on Food Processing and Preservation at MIT, Meerut

The value addition of fruits and vegetables helps in improving the diet quality by supplying essential nutrient (vitamins, minerals, antioxidants) needed for healthy life style. India is processing only 2-3 per cent of fruits and vegetables for value addition of seasonal food items in the form of jam, pickles, beverages, marmalades, squashes etc. on a commercial scale. Therefore, a 15 days (9.6.22 to 23.6.22) training was conducted by Government Food Science Training Center, Modi puram, Meerut for the students of B.Sc. Agriculture at M.I.T, Meerut. Mr. Tejendra Kumar Sharma was in-charge of this training programme.

Shri Tejendra Kumar Sharma told students that most of our food consists of agricultural and livestock products, which are usually seasonal and spoil quickly. Deterioration of food in some cases is accompanied by production of toxic substances while in other cases it results in losses of nutritional value. Therefore, it is essential to possess knowledge of processing and preservation methods that preserve best possible foods over a long period of time with minimum loss of nutritive value.

The skills regarding the food preservation were imparted to about 80 students of B.Sc Ag. (I,II, III & IV year) through lectures, demonstration and hand on training for different food products namely mixed fruit jam, pickle, chutney, marmalades and squash etc. After completion of the training course, the outcome was evaluated through a questionnaire. Government Food Science Training Center, Modi puram issued Certificates to the students after completion of this training programme.

The seminar was completely centered around In Process Quality Assurance and its Validation in Pharmaceutical Industry. The program began at 01:00 pm with the welcome address by Mr. Soumen Pal. The dignitaries on the dais were Dr. Anoop Kumar, Professor, Department of Pharmaceutical Technology, MIET, Mr. Dinesh Kumar, Associate Professor, IFTM University, Moradabad, Dr. Alok Chauhan, Director, MIT and Dr. Neeraj Kant Sharma, Principal, Department of Pharmacy.

Opening remarks and introduction of the programme was given by Dr. Neeraj Kant Sharma. He welcomed all the dignitaries and the speakers Dr. Anoop Kumar and Mr. Dinesh Kumar. 

“Quality Control System – API to Consumer”

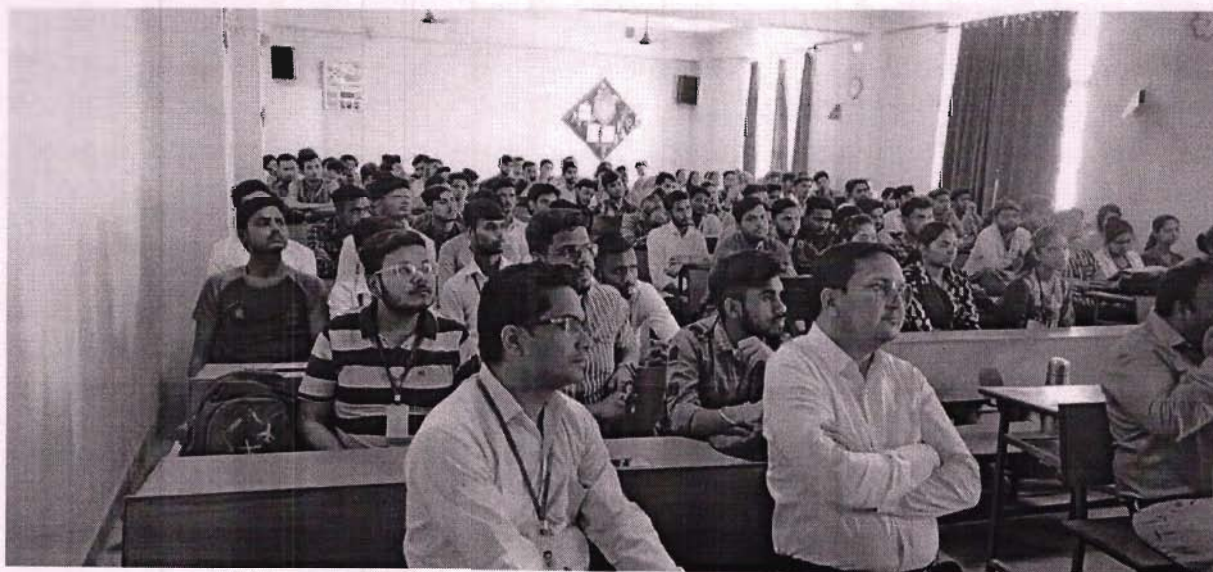

Department of Pharmacy Meerut Institute of Technology (DPMIT) organized a one day seminar on “Quality Control System – API to Consumer” on 11th May 2022 in seminar hall. The seminar focused on significant aspect of quality control in pharmacy profession. The programme started at 10:00 am with the welcome address by Mr. Navneet Kumar. The dignitaries on the dais were Mr. Vivek Mishra, Associate Manager, Pharmaceutical Process, Synokem Pharmaceuticals, Haridwar, Dr. Alok Chauhan, Director, MIT and Dr. Neeraj Kant Sharma, Principal, Department of Pharmacy.

Opening remarks and introduction of the programme was given by Dr. Neeraj Kant Sharma. He welcomed all the dignitaries and the speaker and expressed his gratitude for giving an opportunity to organize a seminar on a theme, relevant to pharmacy profession. All the faculty and students of B.Pharm attended the seminar.

The speaker **Mr. Vivek Mishra** shared his experience and talked about Quality Control. He emphasized on a significant aspect of quality control is the establishment of well-defined controls. These controls help standardize both production and reactions to quality issues. Limiting room for error by specifying which production activities are to be completed by which personnel reduces the chance that employees will be involved in tasks for which they do not have adequate training.

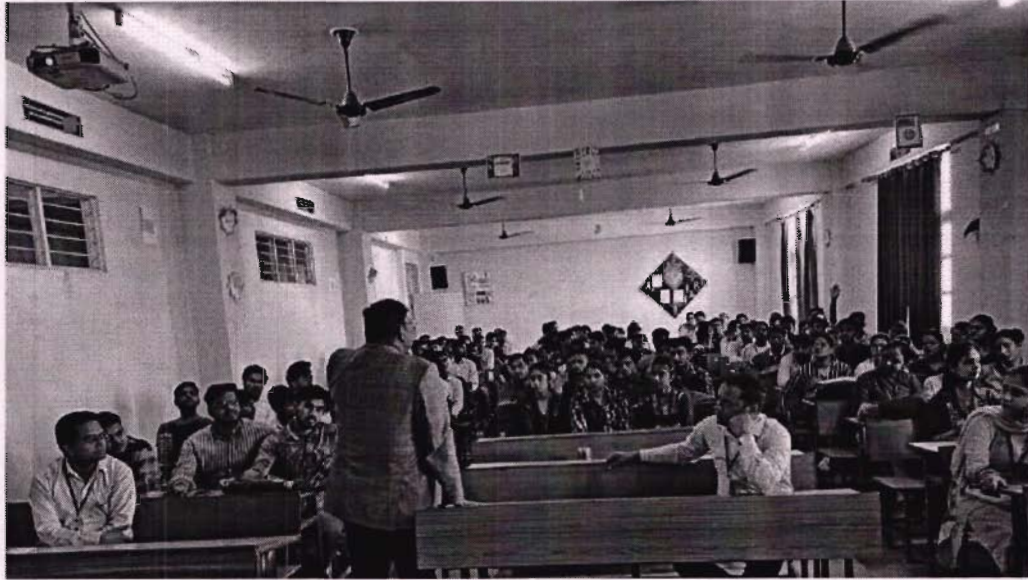


The speaker guided the students about need of quality control. He said creating a product is costly, time-consuming, and can be unsafe without controls in place. Additionally, if a company sends defective products out for purchase, it could be held liable for injuries or issues that arise from using its products. Quality control inspectors ensure that defective or unsafe products are identified, and the causes are corrected.





KEY TAKEAWAYS

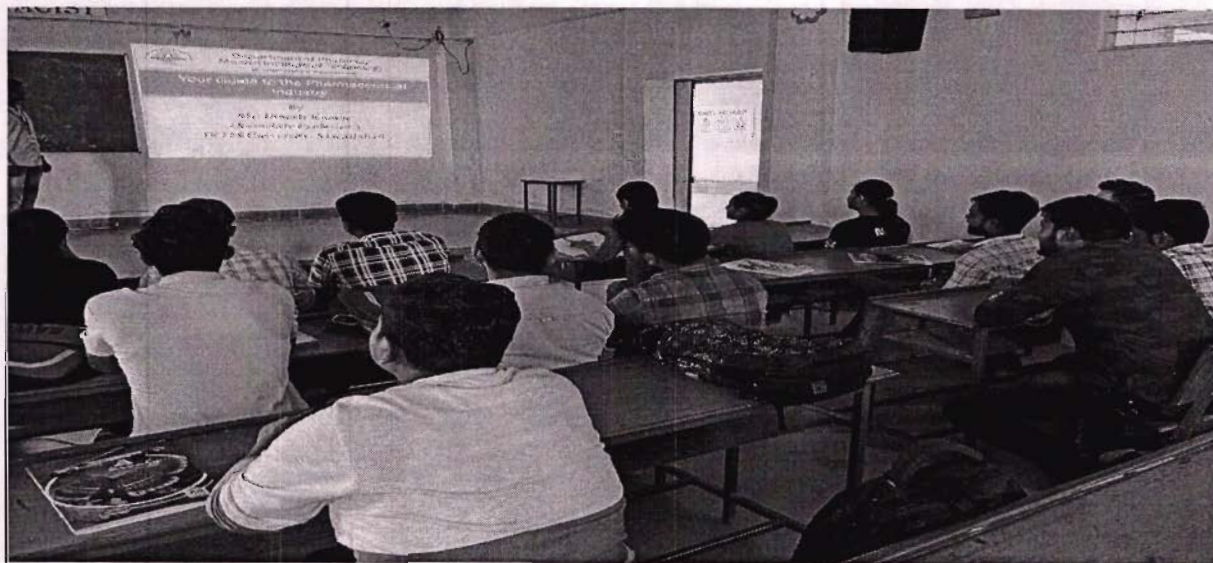

A Report on seminar
(Your Guide to the Pharmaceutical Industry)

Conducted on 9th June 2022

The pharmaceutical industry has changed beyond all recognition in the past 100 years. The modern industry is constantly in the news as new breakthroughs in medical treatment are announced, often provoking ethical and social debates about the implications of new technologies. This seminar facilitates the study of the industry by providing information on the present location of pharmaceutical archives. The core of the book consists of a business-by-business guide to the industry's records.

Mr. Dinesh Kumar, Associate Professor from IFTM University Moradabad has elaborated that how pharmaceutical company developing a drug in a complex and expensive process. It takes many years to develop a drug before it is put on the market. In addition to the science many other challenges must be overcome to successfully bring a new drug to market. Pharmaceuticals are not a class of substances like phthalates or PCBs. They have no chemical, physical, structural or biological similarities. There is thus no scientific justification for treating pharmaceuticals collectively as a coherent set of chemical substances.



He explained that most people are concerned, the Pharmaceutical Industry consists of a small number of very large multinational corporations with household names such as AstraZeneca, GlaxoSmithKline (GSK), Eli Lilly, Merck, Novartis, Roche and Pfizer. These companies are collectively known as Big Pharma, a phrase that is intended to be prejudicial. However, this is very misleading. If you ask a member of the public if they have heard of Teva or Mylan there is a high probability that they will have never heard of either of them, despite the fact that Teva is the 11th largest pharmaceutical company in the world and may very well be supplying the medicine that they are currently taking.



Mr. Dinesh Kumar discussed that Pharma is a dynamic industry with rapid growth and the potential for high profits. Top-selling drugs have annual sales in the billions. However, a new drug requires millions of dollars invested in research and development (R&D) and testing before it can be brought to market. The majority of new projects never receive approval from the Food & Drug Administration (FDA), resulting in large amounts of capital burned just to get one profitable product. Individual pharma stock investors face a difficult task in analysis due to the high level of technical expertise required to adequately evaluate the viability of potential

new products, as well as the continued prospects for existing FDA-approved drugs. The most stable stocks are those of large- and mega-cap companies with multiple products and large R&D budgets. However, the greatest returns come from smaller companies that achieve scientific breakthroughs.

During this seminar student was able to understand the following key points:

- Essential facts about medicines and the structure of the pharmaceutical industry around the world
- About the industry today and the major developments
- Where are the major markets and who are the major players
- Which drugs are the most successful
- Which disease areas are of greatest interest
- How the industry has evolved and how the industry is adapting
- Develop confidence and credibility when talking with your colleagues/clients
- Gain insight into the scientific research conducted to understand serious diseases and innovate new possible treatments.

By the end of this seminar student was confident to talk about the pharmaceutical industry during a presentation, in general conversation with friends. The pharmaceutical industry is one of the most dynamic and exciting professions in the world. It can be hugely rewarding professionally, personally and financially! There are tremendous opportunities for those that are able to develop their expertise and work closely with the pharma industry.

REPORT ON WORKSHOP

“Spectroscopy and Chromatography”

On

14- 16th June 2022

Department of Pharmacy Meerut Institute of Technology organized a three days workshop on **“Spectroscopy and Chromatographic Techniques”** on **14- 16th June 2022** in seminar hall. The workshop focused on developing analytical techniques used for the calibration of chemical constituents of crude drugs. The programme started at 10:00 am on 14/06/2022 with the welcome address by Ms. Manjari Verma. The dignitaries on the dais were speaker Dr. Anurag, Professor, Department of Pharmaceutical Technology, Meerut Institute of Engineering & Technology, Dr. Hasan Ali, Associate Professor, Department of Pharmacy Meerut Institute of Technology, Mr. Vivek Mishra, Associate Manager, Synokem Pharmaceutical, Haridwar and Manjari Verma, Assistant Professor, Department of Pharmacy Meerut Institute of Technology, Dr. Alok Chauhan, Director, Meerut Institute of Technology and Dr. Neeraj Kant Sharma, Principal, Department of Pharmacy Meerut Institute of Technology.

Opening remarks and introduction of the programme was given by Dr. Neeraj Kant Sharma. He welcomed all the dignitaries and the speaker Dr. Anurag, Dr. Hasan Ali, Mr. Vivek Mishra and Manjari Verma and expressed his gratitude for giving an opportunity to organize a workshop on a theme, relevant to pharmacy profession. All the faculty and students of D.Pharm attended the workshop.



On the first day of workshop speaker, Dr. Anurag shared his views on Chromatographic and Spectroscopic Techniques and said that these methods used in standardization of herbal medicines but the herbal system is not easy to analyze because of their complexity of chemical composition. Analytical techniques used to evaluate the quality and quantity of chemical constituent in medicinal plants. He emphasizes on current thinking and practices in standardization of herbal drugs highlighting several integrated approaches. He gave information for developing knowledge of various techniques including HPLC, LC-MS/MS, GC-MS etc with the development of integrated methods for evaluation of botanicals used in traditional medicine

On the second day of workshop was addressed by Dr. Hasan Ali, Associate Professor, Department of Pharmacy Meerut Institute of Technology who talked about the principle, types and their application of spectroscopy techniques –UV, NMR, IR, AAS etc. Dr. Ali also discussed the effect of solvents on UV spectra of different samples. He demonstrated the instrumentation and functioning of various instruments e.g. UV spectrophotometer, HPLC and Thin Layer Chromatography.

Students were given opportunity to operate the instruments and understand the working procedures of various spectroscopic and chromatographic techniques.



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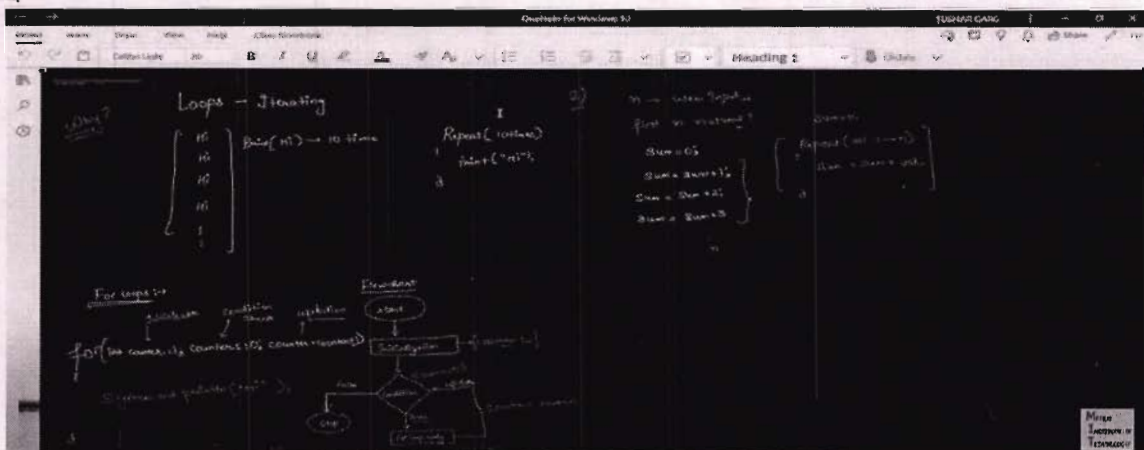
Live Session "A Coding Journey to Product-Based Companies"
