**THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSES AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:**

The purpose of the MOU is to meet the requirement of, IASC SSC and Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut expansion for new technical skill based manpower training and train existing employees and faculty and intern training students in chosen skills of the IASC Sector.

**A. Roles & Responsibilities:**

**Instrumentation Automation Surveillance & Communication Sector Skills Council (IASC SSC)**

1. IASC SSC will enable in position of QP/NOS based & NSQF aligned courses into Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT).
2. IASC SSC will explore the creation or alignments of its existing Qualification Packs (QP) / National Occupation Standards to the curriculum decided by Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT). IASC SSC and Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT) Meerut will jointly work for mapping Skills requirements of the industry demand and student requirements.
3. IASC SSC will support, Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut in development of their training eco-System for imparting skill based training in Instrumentation, Automation, Surveillance & Communication Broadcasting sector.
4. IASC SSC will support Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut in training their faculty under Training of Trainer (ToT) program for imparting skill based training under the QPs of the NSQF.
5. IASC SSC and, Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut will mutually explore possibility of spreading the skilling model in other academic institutions affiliated or relate to Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut.
6. IASC SSC will help and guide, align the training requirement of Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut to industry requirement.
7. IASC SSC will create awareness about the skills program among the Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut students and teaching community
8. MIT along with the support IASC-SSC will facilitate OJT, internship and placement support with industry participation.
9. IASC-SSC will take / propose other measures as may be considered necessary to promote skill based, industry focused programs in the larger interest.

**Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut:**

1. **Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut** will adopt Qualification pack (QP) for training for different job roles as agreed mutually including roll out of courses for Engineering Students to provide them industry focused skill based education.
2. **Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut** will request requirement of new QPs as per specific needs
3. **Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut** will create the labs, working classrooms and teaching infrastructure as advised by IASC SSC for each QP
4. Develop requisite infrastructure for imparting training in specific QPs and deploy all tools and aids as suggested by IASC SSC.
5. **Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut** will provide all faculty for imparting the training and IASC SSC will support in capacity building of the faculty for teaching the QPs
6. **Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut** will share its expertise and best practices in training, forecasting, trends, and research and development etc.
7. **Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut** will take other measures as may be considered necessary to promote the course of skill based industry focused educational programs.
8. **Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut** will facilitate organization of ToT, ToA, and Faculty Workshop etc. as may be required.
9. **Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut** will Endeavour to set up a Centre of Excellence for promotion of ToT, ToA, high end learning, research etc.

**Financials:**

The provision will be worked out mutually between IASC SSC, Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut and SSEPL Skills Pvt.Ltd.as the relationship progresses and these provisions will be respected by both the parties after the same is finalized and will be annexed to this MoU.

**Duration / Term of the MoU:**

- a) This MoU shall be valid for three (3) years from the date of it's coming in force and may be mutually extended from time to time in writing by the parties.
- b) This MoU is a document of good faith. Its implementation would be monitored on a six monthly basis.

### **Changes / Amendment:**

No change can be made to this MoU without written consent and duly signed by all the parties. Additions, deletions and/or alterations to this MoU may be effected with the written agreement of all the parties to this MoU concerning the changes. Documents containing such additions, deletions and/or alterations and signed by all the Parties shall form addenda to this MoU, and be deemed to be part of this MoU.

### **Termination:**

The parties can terminate this MoU after serving 6 (six) months' notice in writing if there is failure/ breach of understanding or default by either party other than on force majeure grounds. At the time of termination neither party shall be liable to other hereunder or in relation hereto for more than the fees paid, including the amounts invoiced but not yet paid. In such a case, it will be ensured that batches running are completed in all respect before termination of relationship.

### **Force Majeure:**

Neither party shall be liable to the other for failure or delay in the performance of any of its obligations under this MoU for the time and to the extent such failure or delay is caused due to acts of God, natural disaster, fire, floods, explosions or earthquake, epidemic or quarantine restrictions, serious accidents, war, riots, or any other cause beyond the affected party's reasonable control, provided that sufficient notice of such occurrence of force majeure is communicated to the other party.

### **B. Governing Law and Dispute Resolution**

This Understanding shall be governed by and constructed in accordance with the laws of India

- i. The Parties shall attempt to amicably settle all disputes arising out of this Agreement and the obligations hereunder ("Dispute"). Either Party may give written notice of a dispute to the other Party within (10) days of the occurrence of the event which gives rise to such Dispute or the date such event comes to the notice of the applicable Party. Any dispute between IASC SSC and Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut in connection with this Agreement shall be referred to the designated officials of IASC SSC and Meerut Institute of Technology (MIT), Meerut for mutual discussions and negotiations.



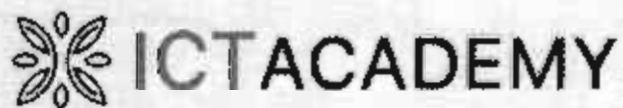

## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered on this day of 05<sup>th</sup> December 2020

### **BETWEEN**

**M/s ICT Academy**, a non profit Society incorporated under the Tamilnadu Societies Registration Act, 1975 and having its Office at B – 308 & 309, Som Datt Chamber – 1, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi – 110066 (hereinafter called as "**ICT ACADEMY**" which expression shall, wherever the context so permits mean and include successors and assigns.)

### **AND**

**Meerut Institute of Technology, Meerut** a technical education institute established under Vishnu Education Foundation and having its office at NH-58, Baral Partapur Bypass Road, Meerut, 250103, Uttar Pradesh, India (hereinafter called as "**MIT, Meerut**" which expression shall, wherever the context so permits mean and include successors and assigns.)


### **WHEREAS**

ICT ACADEMY is established as a society with Initiative of Government of India, State Governments and Industry. It is the pioneering venture under the public-private-partnership (PPP) model that endeavours to train the higher education teachers in the areas of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) thereby making their students to be industry-ready.

The core objective of ICT ACADEMY is to train the faculty members of Engineering, Management, Arts and Science Colleges across the nation. ICT ACADEMY will develop and maintain a world class ICT industry related curriculum and content in close association with Academia and industry, which would be made available to faculty members throughout the state through an online portal. Industry experts would train the learned faculty to keep them abreast of the industry demands and thereby the students. The Academy shall have a core team of faculty members to conduct the training. This core team would be supported by faculty members deputed from Industry as well drawn from the educational Institutions.

### **About Meerut Institute of Technology, Meerut**

The trust "Vishnu Education Foundation" was formed in 2007 by Er. Vishnu Saran, the known philanthropist, and like minded persons. Like minded philanthropists of this region joined hands and took upon themselves the social causes and established charitable hospitals and vocational schools. They felt the need on the turn of the century to train the technical man power for the new millennium and established engineering institutes, hence the foundation of Meerut Institute of Engineering & Technology,





Meerut was laid in 1997 to prepare young man and women for the new millennium. Then promoters founded Meerut Institute of Technology in 2007 under another charitable trust Vishnu Education Foundation.

The promoters realizing the need to train young men and women for the new millennium for the industrialized India under the shadows of Globalization of trade and thus established Meerut Institute of Technology at Meerut in 2007. In 2008 the promoters have established one more institute for educating students in the field of computer application. These institutes are now approved as single Technical campus (or integrated campus) as per latest guidelines of AICTE since July 2010, working in the name and style of MIT Group of Institutions, in 8.598 Acres of land under the preview of AICTE in a phased manner. This Institute is being promoted keeping the above cardinal principles in view Academic excellence, in serene calm environment, state of the art laboratories equipped with all facilities, are its hall mark.

ICT ACADEMY is agreeable to enter into this MOU with MIT, Meerut as per the terms and conditions set out hereunder:

**Now this MoU witnesses as under:**

## **1. Scope of the MoU**

- 1.1 The MIT, Meerut hereby agrees to become the **Institutional Member** of ICT ACADEMY
- 1.2 ICT ACADEMY and MIT, Meerut would collaborate to offer services to the faculty members of the college in the areas of Information and Communication Technology.

## **2 Role of ICT ACADEMY**

- 2.1 ICT ACADEMY shall conduct minimum of ten industry relevant faculty development training program every year in the domain of ICT
- 2.2 ICT Academy conducts Faculty Development Programs and expert-led workshops for the faculty members through Skycampus Virtual FDPs / In-Class Training Programs / Blended mode.
- 2.3 ICT Academy would train minimum 20 faculty members of its member institutions in a year. Every Faculty development Program is supported with effective pedagogical tools for the faculty to use in transferring the knowledge to students in the colleges.
- 2.4 ICT ACADEMY shall provide faculty training and certification for minimum of 03 faculty members of MIT, Meerut for every course, however the maximum number of faculties may exceed up to 15 faculty members per course whenever the venue is at MIT, Meerut campus
- 2.5 ICT ACADEMY shall provide various domain specific training programs either drawn from the Industry or approved by the industry at a subsidized cost to the students of the affiliated institutions based on the interest of the institution



2.6 ICT Academy shall also support the institution in getting the membership and resources from various corporate partners to the university.

2.6.1 ICT Academy will organize 3 SkyCampus Seminars at MIT, Meerut based on the confirmation from the institution.

- Startup Conclave
- Technical Conclave

Among the above organized in a year wherein minimum 3 to 4 industry speakers will be invited to address the students on the topic given by the institution

2.7 ICT ACADEMY would provide training to 3 teachers of MIT, Meerut on every training program apart from the 20 certifications as specified in clause 2.2 whenever the venue is out of the MIT, Meerut campus.

2.8 ICT ACADEMY would invite MIT, Meerut to nominate two teachers on every special training program at free of cost.

2.9 ICT ACADEMY would provide online access to ICT ACADEMY research journals on quarterly basis at free of cost.

2.10 ICT ACADEMY shall notify about the programs to MIT, Meerut and assist in the active participation of faculty members.

2.11 Free Software, Tools, Training & Assessment from ICT ACADEMY Technology Partners

**2.11.1 Oracle Academy**

2.11.2 Free Software – Oracle 11 G (120 Licenses) & Trained faculty will train and certify any number of students at free of cost

2.11.3 The 120 licenses will be provided to each department for the colleges opting for ICT Academy Membership

2.11.4 The licenses provided by Oracle is Academic version which is not meant for Commercial Purpose.

2.11.5 Through the installed licenses trained and certified faculty members will teach the students, provide soft copy materials, conduct exam in Oracle portal and sign the certificate of Oracle for the students.

2.11.6 Faculty members will be trained in Oracle Java Fundamentals and **Java Programming & Oracle Programming using PL/SQL**

2.11.7 No cost involved for the faculty or students to get trained and certified in Oracle programs mentioned above.

2.11.8 The licenses provided by Oracle is valid for 3 years which will be renewed after the mentioned period

2.11.9 The certificate which the faculty getting from Oracle is globally valid

## **2.12 Amazon Web Service Educate member**

2.12.1 On-line training program from Amazon Web Services (AWS-Educate), at free of cost for one year (\$200 credit for each faculty & \$100 credit for each student)

2.12.2 Provide educators and students with resources for cloud-related learning. Those at member institutions receive twice as many AWS credits, demos and special on-campus programs.

2.12.3 Professors, teaching assistants, and educators receive access to AWS technology, open source content for their courses, training resources, and a community of cloud evangelists.

2.12.7 Find Cloud Job

2.12.8 The AWS Educate Job Board includes entry-level cloud jobs from global employers and companies. Students can search job requisitions that match their selected job family and skill set, and apply for positions directly in the Job Board. Features associated with the AWS Educate Job Board are available in all countries globally, with some exceptions.

## **2.13 Skill Development Program with Placement support**

2.13.1 ICT Academy will organize various Skill Development programs in association with industry partners will also be supported by corporate to hire the trained students on various niche technologies. This programs may vary from time to time which will be communicated well in advance to the member college to identify the students.

2.15.1 Articles selected in the conference will undergo one review process to ensure the quality of the paper and it will be published based on the recommendation from the reviewer. ICT ACADEMY will support the colleges in bringing Experts and Professionals from Academia and Corporate to enable the colleges to get the relevant resources according to the conference titles

### **3 Role of MIT, Meerut**

3.1 MIT, Meerut shall identify and depute one Dean / HOD as single point of contact for ICT ACADEMY activities at the university.

3.2 MIT, Meerut shall provide the following infrastructure at its campus for the programs to be conducted by ICT ACADEMY.

- a. Computer Lab infrastructure with 50 seat capacity
- b. LCD projector & Screen, White board and other AV equipments

3.3 MIT, Meerut hereby undertakes that it shall not utilise the contents, training materials, and such other information provided hereunder beyond the scope of this MoU and shall not share such information with any third party or render services utilising the materials, contents, training materials to third parties with out the consent of ICT ACADEMY.

3.4 MIT, Meerut shall provide necessary food facilities to the participating faculty members at no profit no loss and the nominal fee would be charged from the participant faculty members during registration. MIT, Meerut shall also provide necessary food facility free of cost to the resource persons during the programs to be conducted by ICT ACADEMY at MIT, Meerut campus.

3.5 MIT, Meerut shall send a formal communication to all its departments to nominate faculty members for the FDPs jointly organized by ICT Academy.

#### **3.6 Institutional Membership Fees**

MIT, Meerut has agreed to pay INR 59000/- (Fifty Nine Thousand only) to become the Institutional Member of ICT Academy. And the payment details are as follows Online transfer carrying the reference number PUNBH20340056499 on 05.12.2020

### **Other Terms**

3.7 Both the Parties shall explore & jointly develop new courses for the teachers from time to time, the terms for the same will be discussed as and when required and mutually agree upon the terms and the commercials in writing.

3.8 Both the Parties shall explore to work on specific ICT related research areas as per the industry requirements and agreed upon by both the parties.

### **4 Operation of this MoU**

4.1 Upon execution of this MoU, ICT ACADEMY shall communicate to the MIT, Meerut the training schedules. Thereupon, the Parties shall mutually discuss and agree on the operational terms based on which ICT ACADEMY would offer its various other services.

### **5 Validity of this MoU**





5.1 The MoU may be renewed on completion of one year and on the terms mutually agreed to between the Parties. Being failed on which will stand suspended until resolved.

5.2 The Parties shall enter into firm binding agreements on the areas which are not covered under this MoU. Upon the execution of such agreements, this MoU may be terminated. Both parties shall have right to terminate this MoU if any of the party does not comply with its obligations under this MoU by issuing 30 days prior notice.

## 6 CONFIDENTIALITY

6.1 The Parties shall treat all information, documents, contents and materials pertaining to ICT ACADEMY or MIT, Meerut provided under this MoU as confidential.

6.2 ICT ACADEMY or MIT, Meerut shall not disclose any aspect of any confidential information to any third party in any manner whatsoever other than in the normal course of agreed terms under this MoU.

6.3 The confidentiality of information shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

6.4 Upon the termination of this MoU, MIT, Meerut shall return all the contents, training materials and such other information provided by ICT ACADEMY under this MoU duly with out any undue delay and in cases where such information is not capable of being returned destroy the same and provide a certificate that to ICT ACADEMY.

## 9 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

9.1 All the intellectual property rights with respect to the programs, contents provided by ICT ACADEMY shall vest with ICT ACADEMY and upon the termination of this Agreement by efflux of time or such other earlier termination, the college shall not have the right to use programs, contents, and such other training materials installed under this MoU and return the same to ICT ACADEMY. The MIT, Meerut shall not infringe the intellectual property rights of ICT ACADEMY and shall duly intimate of any such infringement by any third parties.

## 10 INDEMNITY

10.1 Both Parties agrees to hold harmless and indemnify, from and against all action, demands, proceedings, prosecutions, attachments, claims or causes of action whatsoever, including (but not limited to) attorneys' fees and other costs arising out of:

- (a) Any breach of this Agreement by both parties
- (b) Any negligence on the part by both parties

## 11 NOTICES

11.1 All notices regarding this Agreement shall be by personal delivery or by certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, at the addresses as either of them may so provide by notice given to the other in the same manner.

## 12 GOVERNING LAW:

This MOU is made under and shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the Republic of India under the jurisdiction of the courts at Delhi.

## 13 ARBITRATION

In the event any of any claim, controversy, dispute or difference between Parties, arising out of or in connection with or in relation to this Agreement, either Party will be entitled refer the same to arbitration in accordance with the rules of arbitration of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. There shall be three arbitrators, one to be appointed by ICT ACADEMY, the other to be appointed by MIT, Meerut and the third to be appointed by the two arbitrators appointed by the Parties. The award of the arbitrators shall be final and binding on the Parties. The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Delhi.

## BACKGROUND:

- A. SAP is enterprise software to manage business operations and customer relations
- B. The Organisation provides SAP training.
- C. The Organisation requires the provision of the services described in item 1 of Schedule A (**Services**).
- D. VU has agreed to provide the Services in accordance with the terms of this agreement.

## AGREED:

### 1. SERVICES

- 1.1 VU will provide the Services in the manner specified in this agreement, with due care, skill and judgment, during the Term set out in item 5 of Schedule A.


- I. Exchange students will be selected by mutual agreement between the home institution and the host institution.

The Parties shall attempt in good faith to resolve any dispute arising out of or relating to this Agreement promptly by negotiation between executives.



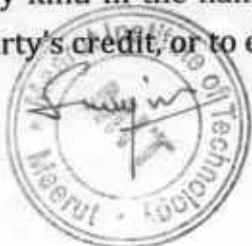

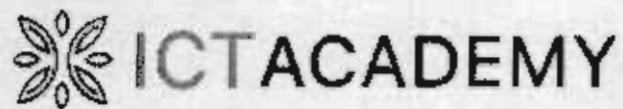

### **WHEREAS**

ICT ACADEMY is established as a society with Initiative of Government of India, State Governments and Industry. 

## 6. Operation of this MoU

## 12 GOVERNING LAW:

This MOU is made under and shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the Republic of India under the jurisdiction of the courts at Delhi.

## 13 ARBITRATION

In the event any of any claim, controversy, dispute or difference between Parties, arising out of or in connection with or in relation to this Agreement, either Party will be entitled refer the same to arbitration in accordance with the rules of arbitration of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. There shall be three arbitrators, one to be appointed by ICT ACADEMY, the other to be appointed by MIT, Meerut and the third to be appointed by the two arbitrators appointed by the Parties. The award of the arbitrators shall be final and binding on the Parties. The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Delhi.

## I - DEFINITIONS

MIET, shall include, unless repugnant to the context otherwise require, its associates- MIT, MEERUT, MIET KUMAON

"Faculty" hereby refers to Training Staff of MIET,

"Students" hereby refers to all the students of MIET

"Program(s)" hereby refers collectively to Career Education program of IBM that includes initiatives like SEED, CEBT etc. for Engineering, IT or Business Schools in colleges and Universities. For more information please refer to <http://ibm.com/in/careereducation>

"SEED" hereby refers to the faculty development training program initiative as Software Engineering for Educational Development

### IV - BREACH OF MOU

In the event of any breach of the terms of this MOU, which is capable of rectification, by either party hereto, such other party shall be entitled to call upon the party to rectify such breach within fifteen days from the date of the notice, failing which the breach shall be deemed to be a material breach, and shall entitle such other party to rescind this MOU for material breach.

### V – TERM AND TERMINATION

The MOU shall be effective from the effective date, and shall be valid for a term of three (3) years, unless terminated earlier by either party, or extended mutually by both parties hereto, on the same terms and conditions as herein.

This MOU will terminate upon written notice by either party. The notice of termination should be issued at least 30 days before the intended date of termination unless extended or terminated earlier. If at any time any party wishes to withdraw from further evaluations and discussions in connection with the subject matter of this MOU and terminate this MOU, it may do so with or without cause and without liability by providing the other party with written notice of its intention to withdraw from further evaluations and discussions. (in case IBM is providing training then IBM to complete the batch in session and or registered

irrespective of termination period / date, subject to all the payments and other obligations having been met by MIET in a timely manner).

In the event of termination of this MOU for any reason whatsoever, including termination due to breach by IBM, any software or courseware licenses granted to MIET by virtue of this MOU, shall also stand automatically terminated without any further act of parties. MIET will also return or destroy at IBM's discretion, all material provided by IBM including courseware slides, soft copy courseware provided by IBM towards trainings.

The following obligations will survive termination of this MOU for any reason:

Use and nondisclosure of confidential information,

Indemnification and Liability,

Obligations to make payments of amounts by MIET that become due by virtue of this MOU, prior to termination.

#### VI – LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Neither party shall be liable for any indirect, punitive, special, incidental or consequential damages arising out of or in connection with this MOU, whether for breach of this MOU or in torts, including loss of business, data, revenue, profits, or for any third party claims against the other (except as specifically admitted by paragraph 2 below) whatsoever.

Except for IBM's obligation to indemnify MIET in the event of breach of third Party Intellectual Property rights (as set out in under the applicable definitive agreement) and except in the event of breach by MIET of any of IBM's Intellectual Property rights or IBM confidential information rights, the Parties agree that either Party's liability for any loss or damage to the other, its customers, or any third party, as a result of or in connection with this MOU, shall not exceed in the aggregate the amounts received by IBM, from MIET under this MOU.

#### VII – ARBITRATION

Any and all disputes, controversy or claims related to or arising in connection with this MOU shall first be referred to Vice Chancellor, MIET or his representative and Country Manager, Career Education program of IBM for an informal resolution.

If this informal resolution does not resolve the dispute, then the matter will be referred to and settled by binding arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The seat of any such arbitration shall be Bangalore. The award of the arbitration may be enforceable in any court of competent jurisdiction. Each party shall bear its own costs and fees in connection with the arbitration.

Unless agreed otherwise, the number of arbitrators shall be three, with each side to the dispute being entitled to appoint one arbitrator. The two arbitrators appointed by the parties shall appoint a third arbitrator who shall act as chairman of the proceedings. Vacancies in the post of chairman shall be filled by the president of the Bar Council of India. Other vacancies shall be filled by the respective nominating party. Proceedings shall continue from the stage they were at when the vacancy occurred. If one of the parties refuses or otherwise fails to appoint an arbitrator within 30 days of the date the other party



appoints, the first appointed arbitrator shall be the sole arbitrator, provided that the arbitrator was validly and properly appointed. All proceedings shall be conducted, including all documents presented in such proceedings, in the English language. The English language version of this Agreement prevails over any other language version.

#### VIII – GENERAL

This MOU shall not be construed to be an agency or a partnership or joint venture or an employment relationship. Neither party shall be entitled to bind the other party with any third party by its actions, unless it has specifically obtained the prior written consent of such other party to do so.

Each party is an independent contractor, and nothing under this MOU shall be construed to create an employment relationship, whether for tax or for any other purpose, nor any partnership or joint venture between the parties. No provision of this MOU grants either party any express or implied right of authority to assume or create any obligations or responsibility on behalf of or in the name of the other party, or bind the other party in any manner or thing whatsoever. Neither party nor its personnel shall be considered employees of the other.

Neither party shall assign or transfer this MOU or any benefits or rights or obligations accruing to it under this MOU, without the prior written consent of the other party.

IBM shall during the term of this MOU be entitled to audit the courseware & the software license usage records of licenses hosted on MIET premises as well as training attendance records maintained by MIET. This audit can be conducted only during reasonable business hours and two weeks notice for audit. Cost of the audit is to be borne by IBM.

The existence and substance of this MOU and the rights and obligations of the parties herein will be kept confidential by MIET and will not be disclosed to any third party without the prior written consent of IBM. Notwithstanding the foregoing, MIET may make such disclosure to the extent required by law, court or statutory authority, in which case MIET will promptly inform IBM to allow IBM a reasonable opportunity to obtain a protective order. IBM and MIET agree not to use the trademark, trade names, services or any other proprietary marks of the other party in any advertisement, press releases, publicity matters or other promotional materials without prior written approval of the other party. Any press release, publicity or media interaction pertaining to this MoU signing or IBM activities on campus need to have prior written consent from IBM. The use of IBM Logo shall be subject to prior written permission by IBM and under the terms of the applicable agreement such as Trade Mark License Agreement executed between and IBM or IBM's parent or affiliates. Any violation of this paragraph will amount to material breach and will lead to the termination of this MoU.

This MOU supersedes all prior oral or written communication, discussions and representations communicated between the parties hereto in respect of the subject matter of this MOU. Any modification to this MOU shall only be made by way of a written document duly executed by representatives of both parties hereto.

If any provision of this MOU is held to be unenforceable or illegal under certain circumstances for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or enforceability of such provisions under other circumstances or the remaining provisions hereof and such provisions shall be reformed only to the extent necessary to make them enforceable under such circumstances.



Any notice under this MOU will be in writing and delivered by hand or by registered mail, return receipt requested, to the other party at the registered office or as may be substituted by the notice. If any notice is sent by mail, notice will be effective on the date of receipt.

MIET shall maintain at all times, a one-point contact for the IBM trainings being conducted at the Institution. Any change in the contacts below will be promptly notified to IBM.

Both IBM and MIET MEERUT are keen to cooperate in a way that shall benefit MIET MEERUT students pursuing a career in the industry.
- b) MIET MEERUT shall rollout Under / Post-graduate / Certificate / value added programs with specialization aligned with relevant IBM Software delivering all or any of such programs to enrolled students and faculty members. IBM shall provide reasonable support as set-forth below to have MIET MEERUT commence and conduct this initiative. Such support may include assistance in the form of providing free IBM software products, identified courseware and academic support through Subject Matter Experts. The provision of software, IBM materials and services shall be under a relevant IBM agreement executed by the parties. Such agreement shall govern the use of software, IBM materials by MIET MEERUT. IBM's responsibilities under this Agreement are subject to MIET MEERUT fulfilling its responsibilities under the MoU.
- c) The curriculum may be provided by IBM or jointly developed by IBM and MIET MEERUT designated subject matter experts. There may be additional specialized offerings and curriculum may be reviewed and updated by IBM and MIET MEERUT from time to time with mutual agreement.
- d) Joint Co-ordination Committee - To guide the execution of the activities agreed under this MoU, MIET MEERUT and IBM Career Education team may constitute a Joint Co-ordination Committee (hereinafter referred to as "Committee") as follows:
  - Vice-Chancellor / Head of MIET MEERUT or his nominee as the Chairperson;
  - One representative from each party as members
  - A Project Coordinator from MIET MEERUT who shall also be the Convener of the Committee.

Chairperson of the committee may recommend changes in the member's from time to time in consultation with the nominating parties and have the same approved by the Head, MIET MEERUT.

The Committee shall recommend on course curriculum, course content, delivery, determination of fee. The Committee shall monitor and review the activities under this MoU and recommend such decisions with respect to any aspect regarding this MoU for the purpose of removing any impediment, promoting the programs arising from this MoU, approving the content and recommending changes therein, the program prospectus and fee structure.

7.4 LICENSEE shall indemnify LICENSOR, its officers, agents and employees from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities (including settlements entered into in good faith), suits, actions, judgments, penalties and taxes, civil and criminal, and all costs and expenses (including without limitation reasonable attorneys' fees) incurred in connection therewith, arising out of:

1. any act, omission, neglect or default of LICENSEE or its agents on or in connection with the distribution, promotion or marketing of Communications; or
2. Personal injury or any infringement of any rights (including copyrights) of any person by the sale, distribution, possession, or use of any Communications; or
3. LICENSEE's failure to comply with applicable laws with respect to the distribution, possession or use of any Communications.
4. any and all third party claims, suits, costs, damages, including punitive damages, liabilities of any kind, and attorneys fees incurred arising out of or related to LICENSEE's use of, or representation about the Licensed Mark or any third party's use of the Communications or its content or any of LICENSEE's products or any other products associated with, used in, or marketed or provided through the Communications.


7.5 LICENSOR's indemnification obligation shall not exceed \$50,000.00.

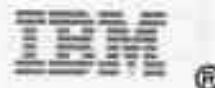

**MPA POWER PROJECTS PVT.LTD, Plot No 155, Sector 47, Gurugram, the Second Party**, and represented herein by its Director, **Mr. Ajay Singh** (hereinafter referred to as "**Second Party**", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in-office, administrators and assigns).

(First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties' and individually as 'Party')

**WHEREAS:**

- A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

**Meerut Institute of Technology, Meerut**

- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest;
- E) **MPA POWER PROJECTS PVT.LTD.**, the Second Party is engaged in Business, Services Like repair of engines, Skill Development, in the fields of **Power**.
- F) **MPA POWER PROJECTS PVT.LTD**, the Second Party is promoted by **Mr. Ajay Singh**; Plot No 155, Sector 47, Gurugram, and Services Like repair of engines, supply of spare parts, on site grinding of crank shaft, Line boring, Honing of liner.

**NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

**CLAUSE 1 CO-OPERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the **Meerut Institute of Technology, Meerut** (hereinafter called as the 'Institution') and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

## **CLAUSE 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU**

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
  - 2.2 **Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
  - 2.3 **Industrial Training & Visits:** Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
  - 2.4 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint training activities in the fields of – **MPA POWER PROJECTS PVT.LTD.Plot No.155, Sector 47,Gurugram.**
  - 2.5 **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
  - 2.6 **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

- 2.7 **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting industrial exposure/ training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 2.8 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 2.9 There is no financial commitment on the part of the second party MPA Power Projects Pvt.Ltd., the second Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be terminated.

### **CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

- 3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

### **CLAUSE 4 VALIDITY**

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period **MPA POWER PROJECTS PVT.LTD.**, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of **MPA POWER PROJECTS PVT.LTD.**, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

## CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that **First Party** and **Second Party** are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.


